

#### **Digicel: 11 Year Market Evolution**

- Digicel commenced operations in Jamaica in April 2001
- Digicel now operates in 31 markets worldwide
  - 23 in the Caribbean
  - 6 in the South Pacific
  - 2 in Central America
- Digicel has over 13 million customers worldwide





#### Digicel's Footprint: Caribbean & Central America






23 Markets in the Caribbean 2 Markets in Central America

# 4G LTE project with the Antigua and Barbuda Government

- Government Assisted Technology Endeavor (GATE)
  - Digicel and the Government have agreed a partnership to deliver GATE;
- The key components of GATE are:
  - Training
  - Education
  - eGovernment
  - Facilities



#### **4G LTE Antigua and Barbuda**

- The Government will receive the following as part of the agreement:
  - Digicel to give 6,000 tablets with LTE connectivity for students
  - Digicel will provide free 4G LTE internet access for 6,000 students from Monday – Friday from 6am to 6pm
  - Digicel will invest in ICT training facility with special needs accessibility
  - Digicel will invest over three years in an ICT Cadet program (program to train people in ICT and secure and create jobs)
- In return for this Digicel received (main items):
  - 700MHz spectrum of its choice free of charge for a period of time
  - Licence Fee Waiver for a period of time
  - Duty waiver on all equipment for LTE network.
