



NOTICE

Revocation of Licence

The Utilities Regulation and Competition Authority (“URCA”) issues this Notice in accordance with section 8(1)(e) of the Communications Act, 2009 (“Comms Act”).

TAKE NOTICE that on August 28, 2012 URCA issued a Final Determination and Order on **Sawtel Co. Ltd.** (“the Licensee”), having determined that the Licensee breached Conditions 1.11.1 and 1.14.1 of the Class Operating Licence Requiring Registration issued to the Licensee on January 18, 2010 to provide public internet services;

AND TAKE NOTICE that on August 28, 2012 URCA issued a Final Determination and Order on the Licensee, having determined that the Licensee breached Condition 4.1 of the Individual Spectrum Licence issued to the Licensee on January 18, 2010 to use radio spectrum to provide public internet services;

AND TAKE NOTICE that on August 28, 2012 URCA issued the said Orders consequential to the said breaches ordering that the Licensee pay all outstanding licence fees and interest thereon within fourteen (14) calendar days of service of the said Orders;

AND TAKE NOTICE that the Licensee has failed and/or refused to comply with the said Orders.

NOW TAKE NOTICE that in exercise of its power under section 27(1)(c) of the Comms Act **URCA has revoked the said licences** issued to the Licensee;

AND TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that under section 16 of the Comms Act, it is an offence for any person to establish, maintain and operate a network or provide a carriage service, including by use of radio spectrum, punishable under section 107 of the Comms Act to a fine not exceeding five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) upon summary conviction.
