



## NOTICE

### Revocation of Licence

The Utilities Regulation and Competition Authority (“URCA”) issues this Notice in accordance with section 8(1)(e) of the Communications Act, 2009 (“Comms Act”).

**TAKE NOTICE** that on September 23, 2011 URCA issued a Final Determination, having determined that **Simon Smith T/A Island WISP** (“the Licensee”) breached Conditions 1.11.1 and 1.14.1 of the Class Operating Licence Requiring Registration (“the Licence”) issued to the Licensee on December 4, 2009 to provide public internet services;

**AND TAKE NOTICE** that on September 23, 2011 URCA issued an Order consequential to the said breach ordering that the Licensee pay all outstanding fees and interest thereon within fourteen (14) calendar days of service of the said Order;

**AND TAKE NOTICE** that the Licensee has failed and/or refused to comply with the said Order.

**NOW TAKE NOTICE** that in exercise of its power under section 27(1)(c) of the Comms Act **URCA hereby revokes the Licence** issued to the Licensee;

**AND TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that under section 16 of the Comms Act, it is an offence for any person to establish, maintain and operate a network or provide a carriage service, including by use of radio spectrum, punishable under section 107 of the Comms Act to a fine not exceeding five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) upon summary conviction.
