ABOUT US:

The Utilities Regulation and Competition Authority (“URCA”) of The Bahamas came into effect on 1 August 2009 as the converged regulator for the Electronic Communications Sector (ECS) in The Bahamas – covering broadcasting, telecommunications, radio spectrum and other forms of electronic communications.

URCA is further strengthening its capacity in policy and regulation of the communications sector and is seeking to employ a suitably qualified individual to fill the post of Senior Case Officer in the Policy and Regulation Department with the requisite competencies and experience in the area of Engineering and Technical Services. The position will be based in The Bahamas and will report to the Director of Policy and Regulation at URCA.

CORE DUTIES – Senior Case Officer, Technical:

The successful candidate will be required to support URCA’s regulatory and policy development activities as required, including:

- Mentoring and development of junior staff within the Engineering and Technical Services discipline.
- Direct policy and regulatory teams in cases and projects within URCA, in accordance with URCA’s strategy and sector policy
- Provide specialist advice, lead projects and cases with emphasis on technical regulation, licensing and spectrum management.
- Ensure effective oversight of the development of various policy positions for URCA supported by activities including but not limited to industry and international regulatory policies and practices.
- Have a good sustainable external relationship with the regulated industry as well as international bodies.

QUALIFICATIONS & OTHER REQUIREMENTS – Senior Case Officer, Technical

The successful applicant must have:

- A Postgraduate Degree in Electrical, Computer or Telecommunications Engineering or equivalent from an accredited university/college;
- Minimum of seven (7) years progressive work experience in the telecommunications industry, consulting or regulation with two (2) years in a team leadership, supervisory or management capacity.
- Minimum of three (3) years progressive, relevant experience with a regulatory body, as a consultant on regulatory matters, or in the regulatory department of a regulated entity.
- Qualifications and or exposure in electronic communications network (fixed and wireless) design, construction and/or maintenance will be an asset.



- Experience in the regulation of a competitive electronic communications market, including required knowledge of spectrum management, monitoring and licensing, and telecommunications network quality of service issues.

REQUIRED EXPERIENCE & COMPETENCIES FOR ROLE:

- Proven experience in managing post liberalization legal and regulatory issues.
- Strong commitment to development of staff and building of regulatory capacity.
- Proven track-record of working independently on major projects, leading multi-disciplinary teams and managing external advisors.
- Strategic outlook and capable of conceptual thinking and decisive decision making.
- Ability to absorb new facts, data and information rapidly.
- Capable of modifying strong views in the face of new information, market realities and compelling logic; and is humble enough to ask questions to ensure an understanding of the situation.
- Strong bias for action and capable of translating the strategic agenda into actionable, quantitative plans, convey a sense of urgency and drive to closure.
- Capable of managing projects from inception within time-frames and approved budgets
- Good communication and inter-personal skills, and the right attitude to be part of a winning team.
