### PRIMARY STUDENTS: GRADES 4 TO 6

#### The Challenge:

Students are invited to dream and imagine their school without chalk and paper, but rather one that fully embraces and uses Information and Communications Technology. Students are asked to depict how they would use modern technology to help their school better serve its students through one of the following:

- write a 200 word essay or;
- produce an illustration or drawing (no larger than 11 inches x 17 inches or;
- produce a video that is three minutes or less

In the Primary category, prizes will be awarded to the top three entries in each of the following sub-categories:

- Essay;
- Drawing/painting or;
- Video

#### Prizes

1st place - \$300 cash and a tablet

2nd place - \$200 cash

3rd place- \$100 cash



## CATEGORY 2

### SECONDARY STUDENTS: GRADES 7 TO 12

#### The Challenge:

Students are invited to produce a five minute or less video clip demonstrating the use of ICTs in a creative and innovative way that provides a solution to one of the following identified areas of national development:

- Health
- Recreation
- Education
- Cyber Security and Privacy
- Island Life and technology
- The Internet of Things
- Disaster Preparedness & Recovery

#### Prizes

1st Place - A smart phone, \$500 cash and a 3-week internship with URCA (2018)

2nd place - \$500 cash

3rd place - \$300 cash



## CATEGORY 3

### YOUNG ADULTS: AGES 18 TO 30

#### The Challenge:

Using ICTs, develop a concept that would enhance the provision of services in any of the six identified areas of national development. (This category is not restricted to the production of a video)

- Health
- Recreation
- Education
- Cyber Security and Privacy
- Island Life and technology
- The Internet of Things
- Disaster Preparedness & Recovery

#### Prizes

1st Place - all expense paid trip to an ITU event to be determined by URCA, cash prize of \$1000 and an invitation to present at URCA sponsored events

2nd place - \$750 cash and Invitation to present at URCA sponsored events

3rd place - \$500 cash
