## AMENDED INTERIM ORDER

THIS DIRECTION IS ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION 8(1)(e) OF THE COMMUNICATIONS ACT, 2009 AMENDS AND VARIES THE INTERIM ORDER DATED 22<sup>nd</sup> JULY 2021 ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION 96 OF THE COMMUNICATIONS ACT, 2009 AND PARAGRAPH 10.11 OF THE CODE OF PRACTICE FOR CONTENT REGULATION ECS/082020 ("the Interim Order") TO ADD AS PARAGRAPH 1.1 of THE INTERIM ORDER, THE FOLLOWING:

## Duration

1.1 The Interim Order issued 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2021 continues to remain in effect pursuant to section 96(2) for the reasonable period of time which URCA requires to complete its investigation in this matter. URCA has considered and decided that it requires a period of three (3) months to complete its investigation in this matter. Accordingly, the Interim Order issued 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2021 shall continue and remain in effect for a **period of three (3) months** from the date issued, i.e., until **Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> October 2021** or until such time as URCA has completed its investigation in this matter, pursuant to section 96(3) of the Communications Act, 2009, whichever is earlier.
